# Driving Directions

## Directions to Austin Convention Center, Ballroom A Austin, Texas

### From IH-35 North:

Take exit #234C: 6th – 12th Streets, turn right (west) at the light onto 6th Street and go 2 blocks. Turn left on Red River and go 1 block. Turn left on 5th Street then turn right into the Austin Convention Center's parking garage.

### From IH-35 South:

Take exit #234B: 8th – 3rd Streets, turn left (west) at the light onto 6th Street and go 2 blocks. Turn left on Red River and go 1 block. Turn left on 5th Street then turn right into the Austin Convention Center's parking garage.

### From Austin Bergstrom Airport:

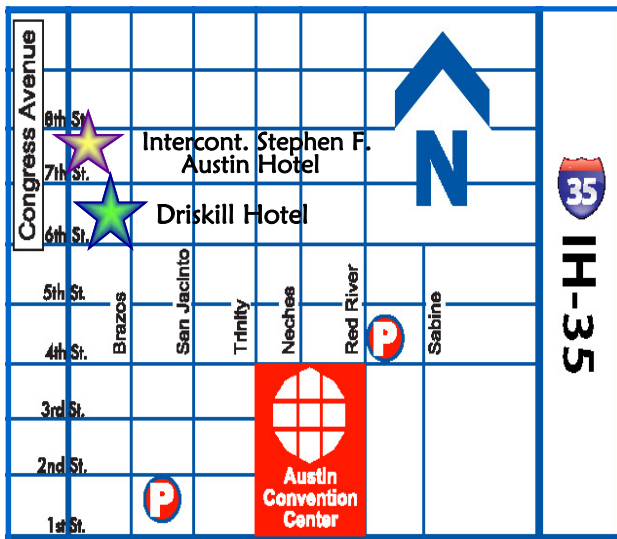
Exit the airport and turn left on TX-71 going west. Continue on TX-71 West & Ben White Blvd. Merge onto I-35 North. Take exit #234B: 8th – 3rd Streets, turn left (west) at the light onto 6th Street and go 2 blocks. Turn left on Red River and go 1 block. Turn left on 5th Street then turn right into the Austin Convention Center's parking garage.

### From MoPac (Loop 1) North:

Take the 5th Street, Lake Austin Blvd, Cesar Chavez Street exit, follow the signs to 5th Street and continue east (toward IH-35, approximately 2 miles). Turn right into the Austin Convention Center's parking garage (1 block before reaching IH-35).

### From MoPac (Loop 1) South:

Take the 5th Street, Cesar Chavez Street exit, follow the signs to 5th Street and continue east (toward IH-35, approximately 2 miles). Turn right into the Austin Convention Center's parking garage (1 block before reaching IH-35).



# Workshop Description

## Background

Sewer systems that are improperly maintained and operated can lead to sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs), a serious public health and environmental problem. The proposed CMOM approach outlines a dynamic system management framework that encourages evaluating and prioritizing efforts to identify and correct performance problems in the sewer system.

## Purpose

This workshop will allow EPA and state regulators to come together with their municipal permit holders to discuss examples of strong CMOM practices. A CD-ROM will be mailed after the workshop that includes the material covered with the registration. The materials are a source of reference for wastewater collection system operators and managers.

## Audience

All municipalities or other special districts that operate and maintain wastewater collection systems, as well as their engineering and management professionals and consultants.
